WORKFLOW

Technical requirements

None, we bring all transmitters and receivers along.

Before the performance

Our partners abroad are asked, to help us finding participants.

Everybody can participate, no skills needed, people only have to do what we tell them to do. Of course we will respect all basic human rights and we will not force anybody to do illegal stuff...if, only a little ;-)

We will supply you with all information and a newsletter-kind email, which can be forwarded, using your networks (mailinglists, facebook, and so on). People that like to participate can sign in on our homepage (we will provide the direct link: actual: http://www.remote-citizen.ch/beschreibungen_EN/anmeldung_teilnehmer_EN.html). After that, we will inform all members directly, that means, our partners will not have to deal with contacting the participants on their own.

The day of the performance

We will need a place, let's say homebase, to put our equipment safely, to meet all participants for preparation, information and training.

All participants will meet at least 2 hours before the start of the performance.

We will have a training, so they get used to the involved equipment, our codes and commands, as well eventually learning some specific movements.

After that, we will hit the road ! As the project is completely wireless, we can move wherever we like to. We won't stay in one place. The contrary: it's about popping up unexpected in squares, streets, places, and disappear suddenly, kind of an endless, moving flashmob. There will not be only learned stuff we perform: as all participants are connected to us by receivers, we easily can interact with given situations and improvise. We likely do a kind of a tour through cities, walking up to 5 kilometers.

After the performance we will get back to our homebase.

If possible it would be very nice, if our partners could provide some beverages and small food to the performers.
